

# Old World Dance Club

## Folk Dance Camp at High/Scope

### Friday–Sunday, May 2–4, 2008

**You may arrive at the camp on Friday any time after 7:00 PM.**

**From the North (including northern Detroit suburbs):** Take US-23 south (from Detroit area take M-14 west to US-23 south). Continue south past Ann Arbor. Continue past I-94. Very soon there will be an exit to US-12. Take this and head west. Drive through Saline (about 10 miles) and then on to Clinton (about 10 more miles). Drive through Clinton and after about 2 miles you will reach Sheridan Road (if you reach M-52 you've gone too far). Turn right (north) onto Sheridan and go about 1½ miles. The entrance to the camp will be on your right. If you cross a bridge you've gone too far.

**From the East (Detroit or Canada):** Take I-94 west to US-23 south. Very soon after getting on to US-23 there will be an exit to US-12. Take this and head west. Drive through Saline (after about 10 miles) and then on to Clinton (about 10 more miles). Drive through Clinton and after about 2 miles you will reach Sheridan Road (if you reach M-52 you've gone too far). Turn right (north) onto Sheridan and go about 1½ miles. The entrance to the camp will be on your right. If you cross a bridge you've gone too far.

**From the West (Chicago):** Take I-94 and exit M-52 south. Continue on through the town of Manchester to US-12 (about 20 miles). Turn left (east) onto US-12. Very soon after the turn you'll find Sheridan Road. Turn left (north) onto Sheridan and go about 1½ miles. The entrance to the camp will be on your right. If you cross a bridge you've gone too far.

**From the South (Toledo):** Take US-23 north to the exit to US-12. Take this and head west. Drive through Saline (after about 10 miles) and then on to Clinton (about 10 more miles). Drive through Clinton and after about 2 miles you will reach Sheridan Road (if you reach M-52 you've gone too far). Turn right (north) onto Sheridan and go about 1½ miles. The entrance to the camp will be on your right. If you cross a bridge you've gone too far.

**Parking:** Parking is allowed on the grass on either side of the loop drive in front of the barn.

#### **What to bring:**

- Sheets and blankets, or sleeping bag – the mattresses are all twin size. (Linens can be rented for \$6/weekend)
- Pillow
- Toiletries
- Towel, etc. - keep in mind that showers and bathrooms are down the hall (there are no private baths)
- Alarm clock
- Extra shoes for dancing – the camp management requires that **shoes worn outside must NOT be worn on the dance floor** (in the barn). There are cubbies in the barn to store your extra pair of shoes.
- Flashlight
- Warm clothes – it can still get quite cold at night in May (despite, or because of, global warming).
- Rain gear (hopefully you won't need it)

(If you forget anything, the town of Clinton is only a few miles away.)

#### **Your responsibility:**

- Before leaving on Sunday, campers are required to empty their own trash cans into containers that will be placed in the entrance area of each building.
- Returned linen rentals must also be placed neatly in the building entrance areas.
