Friday-Sunday, May 13-15, 2011, at Clear Lake Camp near Battle Creek, MI

Tom Bozigian, was born in Los Angeles of Armenian parents. He is an internationally recognized dance instructor. He is a graduate of the Armenian State Choreographic Academy and also holds a Bachelor of Arts Degree (B.A.) in Russian Area Studies and a Master of Arts Degree (M.A.) in Education from Fresno State University. He is fluent in three languages: English, Armenian and Russian. He unites the elements of professional dancer-choreographer/linguist/musician to support his far-reaching research on the subject of Armenian dance ethnography. Tom Bozigian is particularly sought out for his extensive knowledge of dances from the pre-1915 period and has presented some of his material to institutes and ensembles throughout Armenia. His dance expertise also covers dances of the Armenian Diaspora and new folk dances. Tom Bozigian's teaching has taken him to most continents of the world. He has been commissioned to set suites of Armenian dances for both Armenian and non-Armenian dance ensembles in various countries, and he regularly tours the Orient and Europe teaching Armenian dance. He is also an accomplished percussionist with nearly 45 years of performance experience as a dancer/singer/musician. Presently, he teaches weekly classes in Armenian dance in southern California and plays with his trio of folk musicians who have recently recorded two CD's. He also regularly records with the Armenian State Television Ensemble for Folk Instruments which has also been included on his CD's. [to learn more: www.bozigian.com]

He will be joined by his wife, Sheree King, a dancer, choreographer and certified Pilates instructor.

Clear Lake Camp & Conference Center is part of Battle Creek Outdoor Education Center, and is located 17 miles north of Battle Creek. The 175 acre facility is situated on Clear Lake in a stand of very large trees with a swimming beach, canoes, and rowboats. The historic Kellogg Lodge was built in 1935 and houses dancing and dining areas. Sleeping arrangements are dormitory-style in two buildings across a small parking lot from the Kellogg Lodge, with a variety of room sizes sharing common facilities. The camp has a reputation for excellent food served family style.
